ORCID was founded to deliver a specific goal: every researcher who wants to have a unique lifelong identifier should have one, and be free to use it in their daily work. Every time a researcher, scholar, or other knowledge worker shares their ideas, they should be able to connect their identifier to their ideas. Every expression of knowledge – in whatever form it takes – should be connected to the people who created it and the places and spaces where the ideas were developed. This is summed up by our [vision](#) of a world where all who participate in research, scholarship, and innovation are uniquely identified and connected to their contributions and affiliations across disciplines, borders, and time.

INFRASTRUCTURE

The ORCID Board completed a self-assessment this year, and a thorough review of [ORCID governance policies](#) has resulted in the creation of a [Board Charter](#) and clarifying updates to our bylaws. We undergo annual external audits of our financials, led by our [Audit Committee](#) and supported by Operations Director [Sarah Hershberger](#). **We are thrilled to declare that in 2019 we have reached breakeven!** In addition to a financial audit, we also undergo an annual external privacy and security audit, this year led by [Will Simpson](#), who in addition to being our Technology Director has assumed the mantle of ORCID Privacy Officer. And if that is not enough in one year, Will and Sarah worked with the Audit Committee to create a risk register, which we are using to prioritize actions for the coming year.

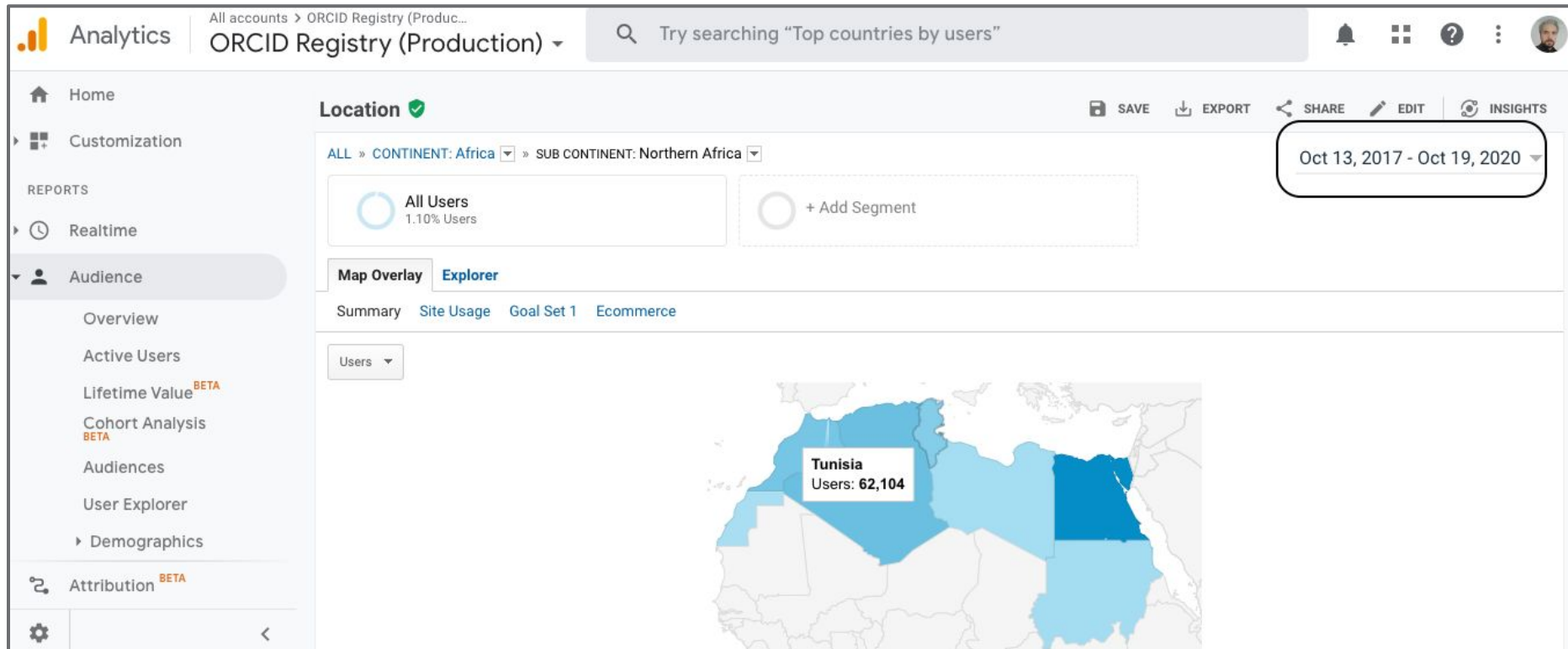

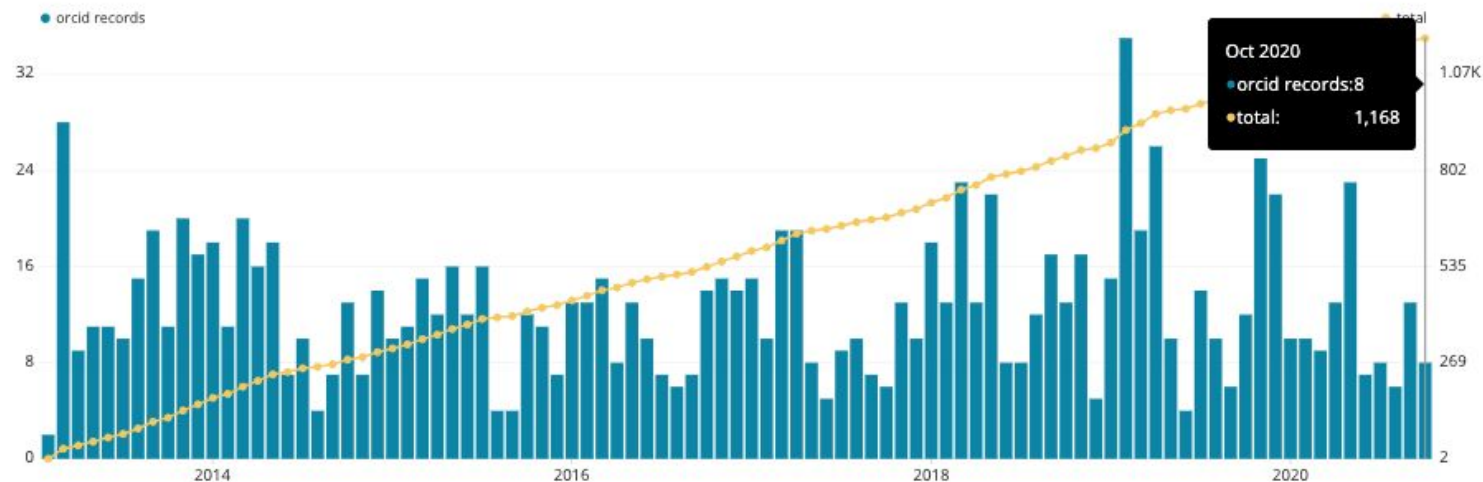

criterion of the Ranking[8,9,10] though that this metrics has some deficiencies[10]. As for the names of the scientists, as we do not have a complete list of scientists in Tunisia, we will gather Tunisian Surnames from Scopus Websites, Essential Science Indicators Highly Cited Papers, Web of Knowledge, the Research Gate, the Phone Directory, Microsoft Academic Search, LinkedIn and the Google Scholar[7,12,13] as well as from Conferences held in Tunisia of some organizations like IEEE and the FIP, from lists of Visiting Professors and Researchers in Tunisia, from Official Websites of Tunisian Universities, from a paper that talked about Scientific Production in Tunisia[14] and some biographical reference books[15,16] and some nominations from some Tunisian Consulted Working Scientists and we will later test each of them in Google Scholar My Citation Search Toolbar as it is the fastest and the most precise tool to search scientists in Internet[17] because from a theoretical side, it gives the list of scientists in a few seconds as it uses the Google Database directly while Harzing PoP4 uses



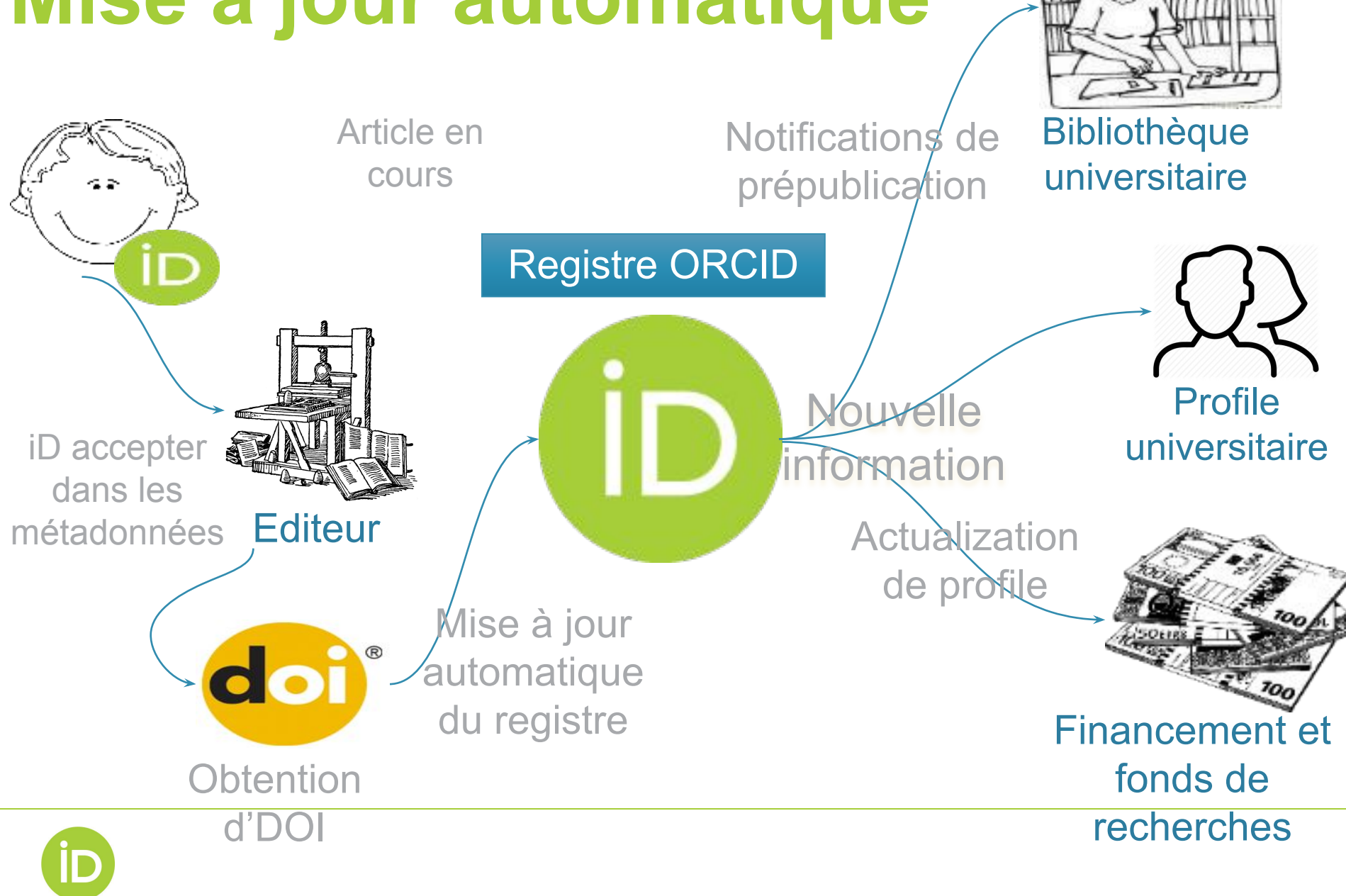

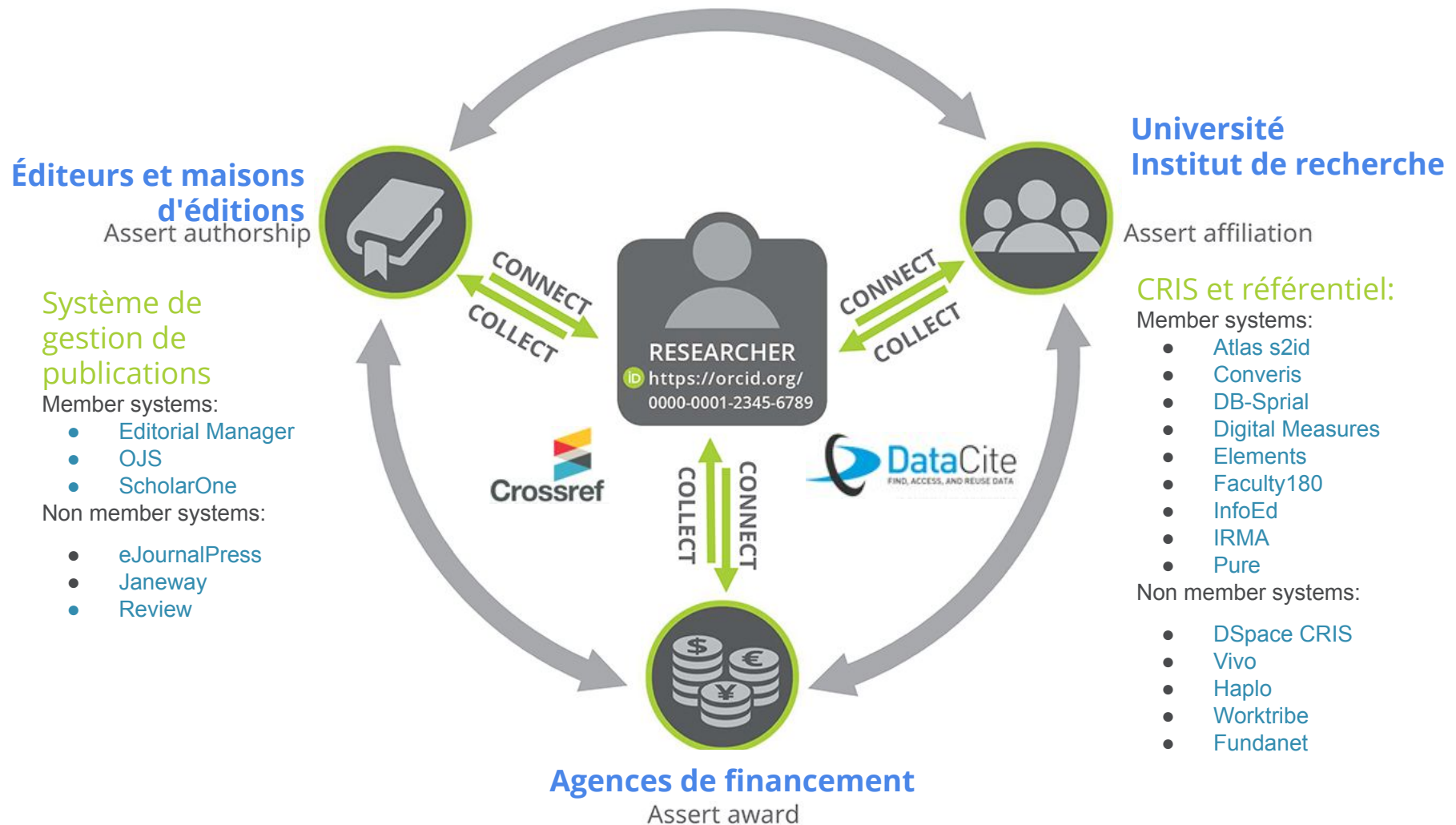

NRF ORCID Statement

The NRF requires that all researchers and students applying for funding and rating at the NRF have an ORCID* identifier.

The NRF is in the process of integrating the ORCID identifier into all application and grant management business processes and systems and will allow researchers to include their ORCID identifier when updating their CVs. The NRF is also considering the downstream integration benefits to both researchers and the NRF including automated processes for uploading research output records into a researcher's profile and annual research reports.

A unique identifier, as provided by ORCID and which researchers can associate with their name variations and their research works, is a way to ensure that these links can be made accurately and reliably. This will help researchers to uniquely identify themselves as the author of their work across all systems integrated with the ORCID registry.

The NRF membership of ORCID ensures that researchers and their institutions will benefit from access to and integration with the ORCID registry, including setting up and maintaining disambiguated records for all researchers and linking these to their publications and other research outputs, leading, in turn, to a simpler, more reliable evaluation process.

** ORCID is an international, interdisciplinary, open and not-for-profit organisation created in 2010 for the benefit of all stakeholders, including research organisations, research funders, publishers and researchers. 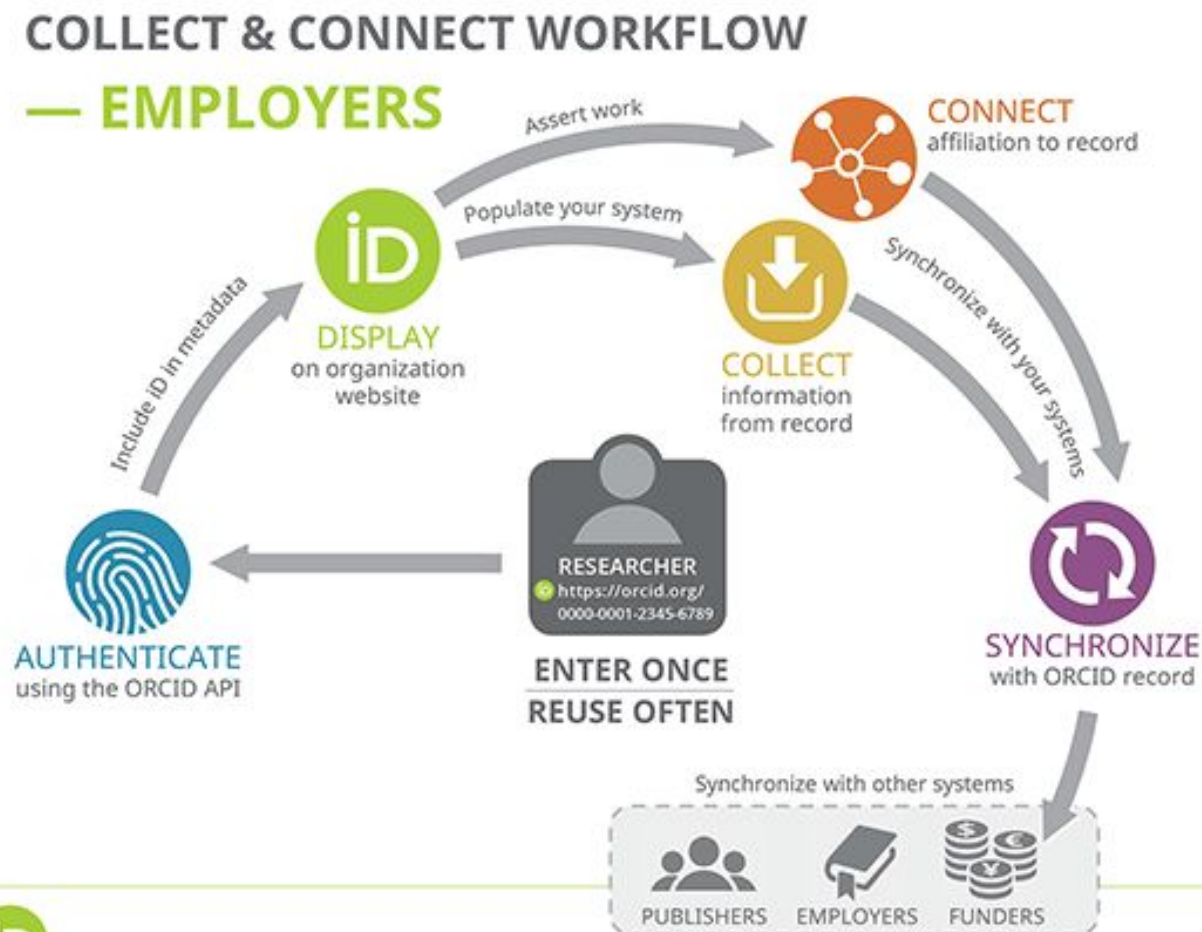

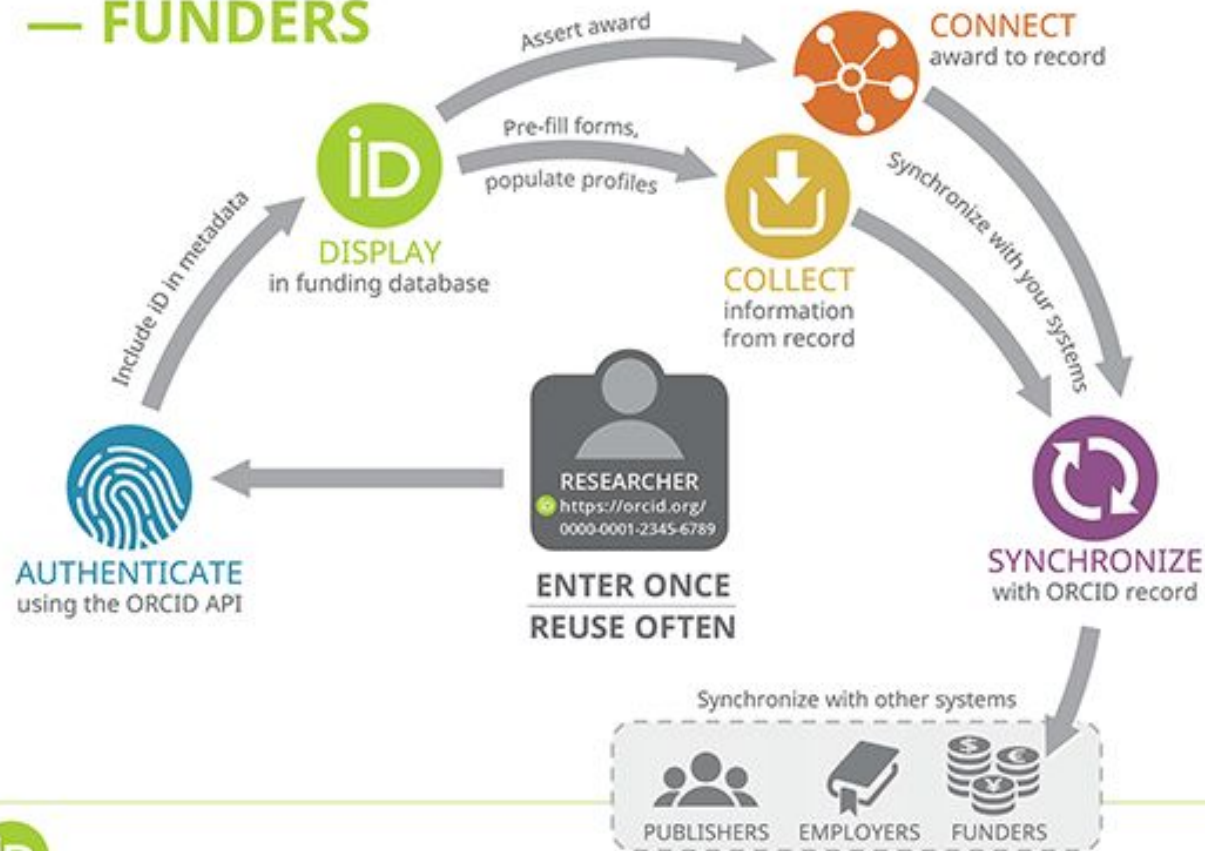

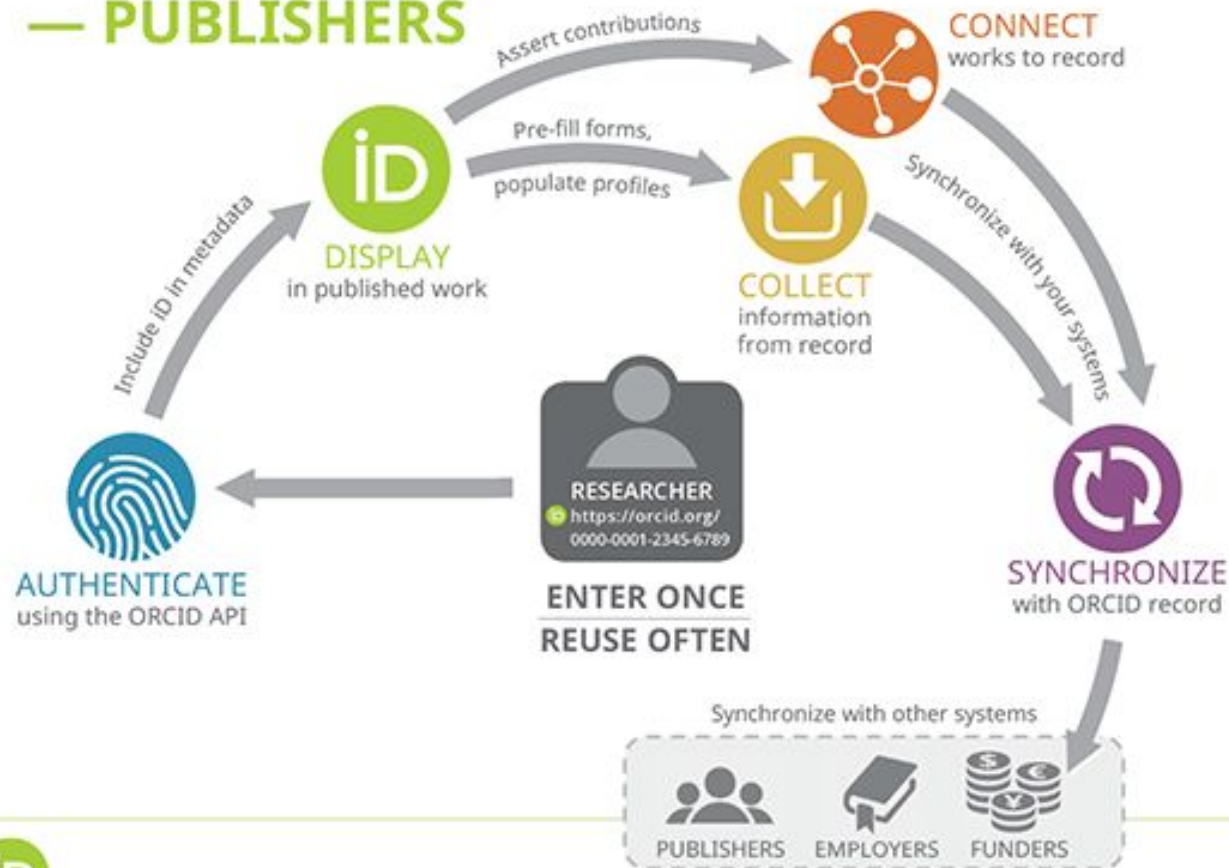
