# The NZ ORCID Hub

#### Why a Hub?

- The New Zealand ORCID consortium is a mix of large and very small organisations.
- Not all, or even most, have the resources to develop integrations with ORCID but with ORCID to be a key part of the new NRIS they need assistance, i.e., the NZ ORCID Hub.

#### • What is the Hub?

- The Hub is a web service that sits between the organisation and ORCID, performing OAuth dance with their staff/students and acting on the information they've provided.
- It allows any consortium member to write authoritative information to ORCID records.



# How the Hub works

## Four roles exist in the Hub:

- Hub Administrator
  - OrganisationTechnical Contact
  - Organisation Administrator (optional)
    - Researcher/Contributor
