



#### **ORCID API: Application Programming Interface**







Change Default Name	You can change the default name used to pre-enter the author, presenter, performer, artist, and other like contributor fields for new entries in the CV Database. This name is also used to identify the faculty member among the list of contributors in the research summary report.	
Change Default Publish CV Options	When you publish your CV, a copy of the CV will be posted to the public web site. You can select the format that will be used the next time that a CV is posted to the public site. In addition, the expertise keyword search in the public site will, by default, include expertise (language proficiency, areas of expertise, and international affiliations) from CVs, even those that are In- Progress. A function is provided to prevent your expertise from being indexed for this public keyword search.	
Override Start and Review Dates	The Promotion and Tenure CV and the specialized faculty promotion CV footnote professional activities that occurred prior to your employment at FSU and prior to your last promotion review. By default, the hire date and review date are determined from the Professional Experience category from your CV. This function permits you to override these dates when generating a P&T or promotion CV.	
Connect your ORCID iD	Register and connect your ORCID iD. This will establish a connection between your ORCID information and your FEAS information. This may be used to download ORCID "works" into the FEAS database as entries. You may optionally establish a trusted relationship between ORCID and FSU which may be used to download those ORCID works which are only accessible from trusted sources.


#### WHY USE ORCID?

- Save time & reduce administrative burden by using automated data transfer through ORCID
- Comply with requirements for funding applications & reporting
- Distinguish between individual researchers who share the same name
- Track, Manage, and Share data across stakeholder systems & work-flows
- **Connect** with other research information systems, within & outside your institution
- Improve the **visibility** of your contributions
- Manage your reputation & research impact
- Ensure that you are accurately linked with your research, contributions, & affiliations, to **get credit for your work**

#### Planning on Publishing?

**61** publishers require authors to have and ID from ORCID when submitting their work. A small smaple of these publishers include:





#### **Connecting FEAS & ORCID:** 1. Log in to FEAS+ at https://feas.fsu.edu 2. Click the "Import" button 3. Click the "Import ORCID" button

- 4. If you have not linked your ORCID account through your FEAS Preferences, click on "Register or Connect your ORCID iD"
- 5. Once your ORCID is linked, we encourage faculty to "Request a trusted relationship" with FSU
- 6. Next, click on "Import Works"
- 7. Once the import is complete, click "Accept Imports" or "Review Imports" to jump to the CV Builder

# DISTINGUISH YOURSELF

THREE EASY STEPS

Register with ORCID for a unique identifier that distinguishes you from every other researcher and scholar and supports automated linkages among all your professional activities.

An ORCID iD (or ORCiD) is a unique 16-character identifier that's assigned to you when you register. Registration is free and your ORCiD is portable-it's not affiliated with any institution.

Use your ORCiD when submitting:

- a manuscript to a publisher,
- a grant proposal to a funder, or
- a dataset or publication to your institutional or another repository.

Populate your MSU Digital Measures account simply and efficiently by importing publication data from your ORCiD record. Whenever there's an opportunity to link your works and scholarly activities, your ORCID iD saves you time!

## **VIVO** at the Libraries

- Originally planned as replacement for longstanding project MSU Authors
- Goals:
  - Incorporate data faculty enter in Digital Measures, info from ORCID, and existing info from departed/deceased faculty in MSU Authors
  - Use Digital Measures as single source of truth while promoting ORCID as a way to present that information to the world





## VIVO at MSU

- Caught attention of Associate Vice President for Research Development Allen Parrish
- Dr. Parrish discovered similar projects in several other groups and convened us all into a working group:
  - Information Technology Services
  - Office of Public Affairs
  - Office of Institutional Research and Effectiveness
  - Office of Research and Economic Development
  - Various academic departments and research centers



### Expectations

#### • Standardize faculty info

- All faculty directories on the MSU domain will be replaced with a standard layout (which mirrors VIVO's default theme) which draws all info from Digital Measures (also integrated with ORCID)
- Pilot: College of Business <u>https://www.business.msstate.edu/directory</u>

#### Reduce workloads

- Office of Public Affairs will be able to close their homegrown Faculty Experts site <u>https://www.msstate.edu/directory/faculty-experts</u>
- Faculty will only need to enter any info about themselves or their research into Digital Measures to populate several different systems

#### • Enable discovery

- MSU administrators and external entities will be able to get a quick and more complete picture of research activity at MSU
- MSU researchers will be able to quickly and easily find collaborators in other departments and research centers across MSU



### Successes

#### • Dr. Parrish loves it!

- Admins very impressed by everything VIVO can do
- Lends more importance to entering research data into Digital Measures

#### • Librarians love it!

- VIVO and ORCID provide us with another way to assist MSU researchers in getting their work seen, funded, and archived
- ORCID integrated into VIVO and Digital Measures!
  - It is there, and it works...



### Challenges

• ORCID integration is not quite "complete" enough yet

- Digital Measures only ingests 1 or 2 types of material from ORCID
- ORCID link in VIVO must be initiated (or delegated) by researcher...but we don't want researchers to have to log in to VIVO
- ORCID adoption isn't widespread enough on campus yet
  - We're working on ways to market it to researchers, especially those just starting out

#### • VIVO implementation proving difficult

- We only have 1 developer
- We both have other projects
- No previous RDF, XML, or SPARQL experience, so training is necessary before we can move forward

#### • VPs considering a different solution

• They might purchase Academic Analytics, which effectively moots our VIVO work
