

ORCID IN THE AMERICAS

Registry traffic: Individual Researchers +21% in Latin America ($1.2M \rightarrow 1.5M$), +12% in US & Canada ($2.4M \rightarrow 2.75M$)

Four consortia:

Brazil, Canada, USA (2)

Membership: Organizations
+38% in Latin America (21 -->34),
+36% in US & Canada (259 -->275)

Integrations: Organizations connecting systems
+31% in Latin America (9 -->16),
+29% in US & Canada (177 -->249)
