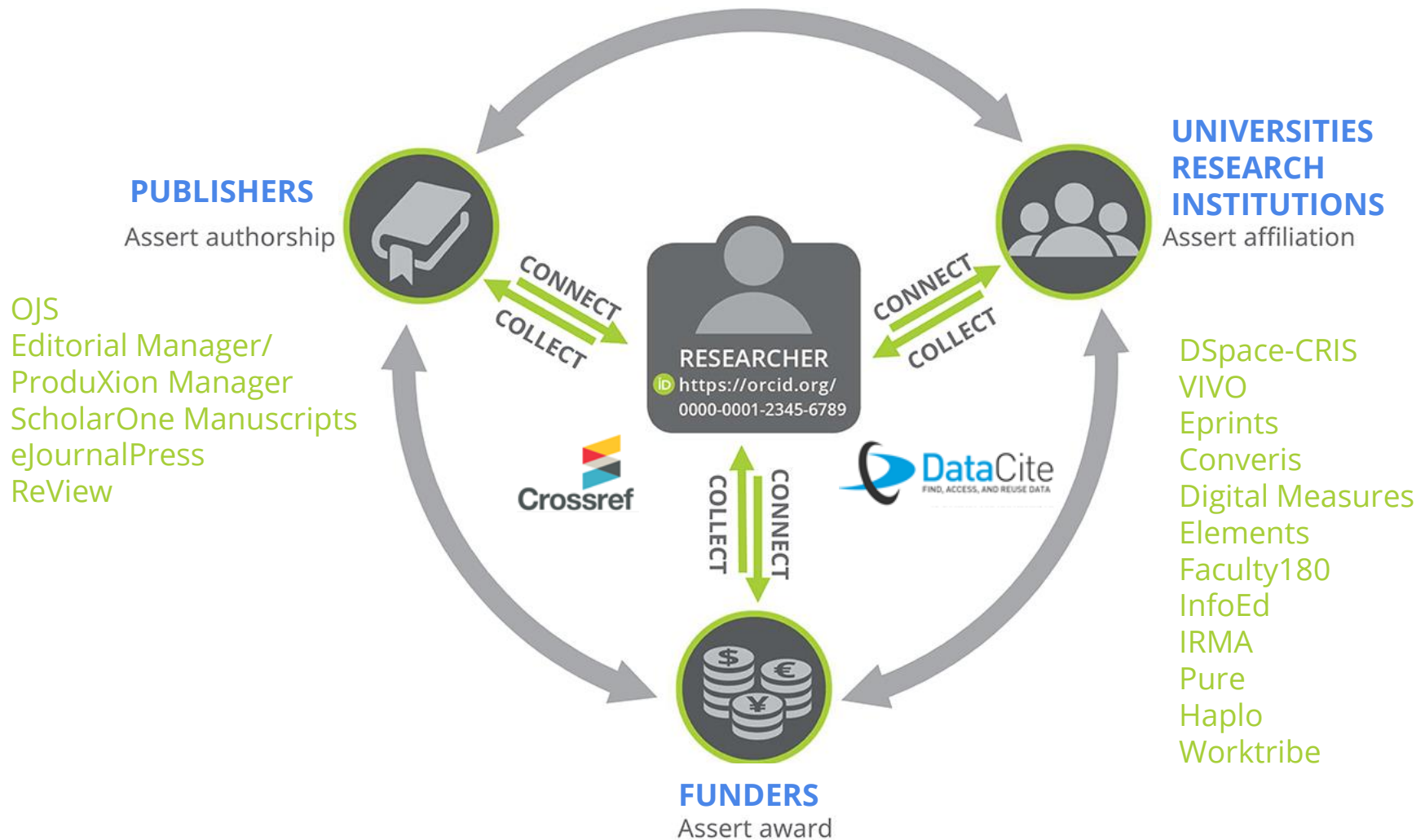
What is ORCID?

- ORCID is an open, not-for-profit organization run by and for the research community
- We provide researchers with a unique identifier, an ORCID iD, that reliably and clearly connects them with their research contributions, affiliations, funding & facilities
- We provide open tools (ORCID iDs, Registry & API) that enable transparent connections between researchers, and identifiers for their activities & contributions

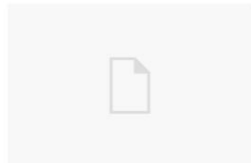


Our Public Data File

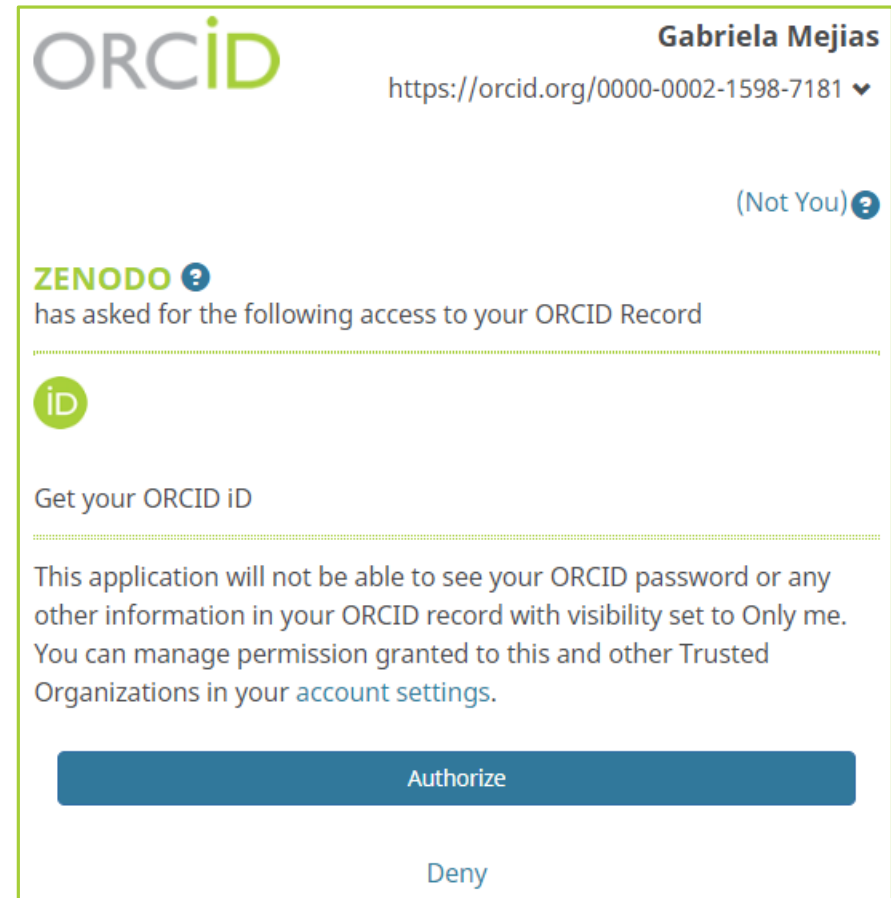

1. Authenticate

- Use OAuth to collect authenticated ORCID iDs and read/write/update permissions
- Store all authenticated iDs & full token exchange data within the integrated system
- Do not allow users or admin to search for or type in ORCID iDs as a method of associating an iD with a person



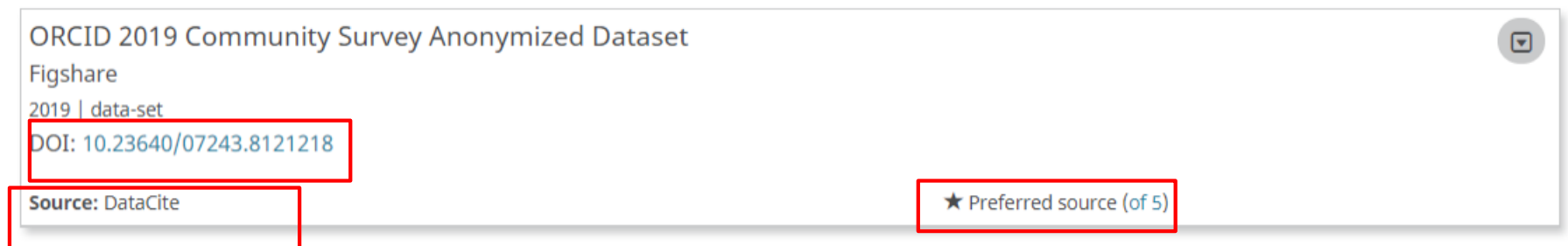

2. Display

- Display iDs as per our guidelines
- Embed iDs in metadata

- Add data that you can uniquely assert
- Store put codes
- Minimum metadata requirements (PIDs)

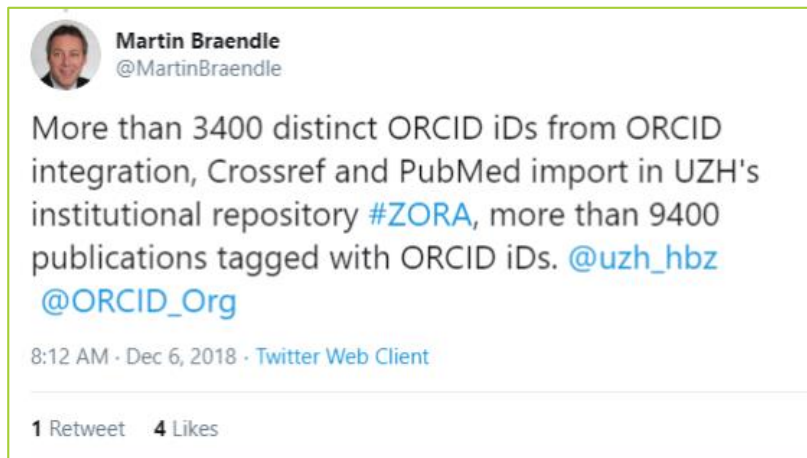

4. Collect

- Request & use permission to read information
- Auto-populate your systems & forms



15. How can I import the works of my ORCID record into ZORA?

For quality reasons, only submitters trained by HBZ are allowed to deposit publications in ZORA.

In order for a submitter to import the publications on your behalf from your ORCID record into ZORA, you must grant him or her the right to use your ORCID iD. Log in to ZORA (→ [Login](#)). Click on your name or on "Profile" in the ZORA menu to go to your ZORA account page. In the "Profile" section, click on the "Edit" button. Then enter the shortname of the delegated person in the "Delegated user" field and click on the "Save and Return" button.

If you own the submitter role, select the option "ORCID Import" on the page "Manage Deposits" and click the "Import" button. Then select either your own iD or the iD of a user who had delegated you.

5. Synchronize

- Register webhooks for observed iDs
- Update data in your systems & in ORCID (put codes)
