Active and Growing Base of Users and Members



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Active Member Community



By the end of 2019, **49,252,213 work items** had been connected to ORCID records — an increase of **34%** over 2018.


Of these records, **32,982,354**

were added through **member API integrations** — an increase of 40% over 2018.

Ensuring Ease of Use

In 2019 we created a dedicated Researcher Services team. We focused on user query response time and user experience.

- We implemented a new tool to manage user service alerts and eliminated spikes in ticket numbers
- Beginning to see decrease in response time since new tool implemented
- We collected information on the major classes of user questions and prioritized UX improvements





Improving our Product

In 2019, we improved the ways researchers can manage their record, including <u>grouping and DOI lookups</u>.

We released <u>API 3.0</u> that expanded record affiliation types to include invited positions and distinctions, membership and service, and also supports acknowledgement of <u>research resources</u>.

Nearly **700K of these new affiliation types** were added to ORCID records in 2019.



Understanding our Communities

2019 Community Survey

11,201 respondents

84% agree that requiring ORCID iDs is beneficial to the global research community.

ORCID is no longer viewed as a "New" organization; instead, "Widely used," "Global," "Open," "Efficient," and "Easy to work with."



ORCID Events

Workshops: We hosted 17 events with over 800 participants **Webinars**: We hosted 18 events with 1215 attendees

Working Groups: We hosted 6 working groups and task forces

Conferences: We attended < 90 events across sectors and regions

Twitter: We grew our follower base by 25% to 31.5K



Becoming Sustainable

Since our founding, a key milestone for ORCID has been reaching financial sustainability. For us, that means being fully supported by membership fees. We hit that breakeven point and ended 2019 in a strong cash position.

- Actual vs. budgeted expenses. We tracked at or under budgeted expenses throughout 2019.
- **Earned revenue.** We had YOY growth of 14% in our accrued membership revenue and maintained membership retention at greater than 95%. We have a healthy annual recurring revenue of \$4.25M at 2019 EOY.
- **Trajectory to break-even.** At 2019 EOY, we reached break-even, the first fiscal year in which our total revenue exceeded our operating expenses.
- **Cash management.** Cash on hand on 31 December was \$3.4M, well over our 3-month operational requirement. We automated A/R and have significantly improved the timing in which we receive member payments.



Achieving our Mission

Our work is centered on our four core strategies:

RESEARCHERS. Position the researcher at the center of all that we do

TRUSTED ASSERTIONS. Enable a wide range of verified iD-ID connections

INFRASTRUCTURE. Invest in developing a robust information infrastructure

STRATEGIC RELATIONSHIPS. Develop sustainability through strategic relationships.

ORCID launched its Registry service in October, 2012. Now, with over 1100 members and 600 systems around the world that use the ORCID API to collect ORCID iDs, ORCID has grown to become an integral part of the global research infrastructure. Persistence – both in terms of *patience* and *prolonged existence* – is critical, especially in these times of uncertainty and change. Over the last 8 months, we have taken a deep look at our core strategies and developed a 2025 vision focused on reliability and resiliency.



Our 2025 Vision

As we look to the future, these questions emerge from our core strategies:

- Will <u>researchers be able to use ORCID</u> to enhance their ability to undertake, communicate, evaluate, and promote their research and in a variety of settings as they are doing their work?
- Will we be providing <u>high quality data</u> in a way that researchers and their organizations value?
- ➤ Will we be able to increase adoption and <u>scale our operations</u> effectively and efficiently?
- > Will our partners and members <u>gain value from adopting</u> ORCID?

Our 2025 vision is a 5-year framework by which to organize and prioritize our activities and measure and communicate our progress. Each core strategy is aligned with specific goals, each of which is supported by our activities and measured using key performance indicators.



ORCID in the Americas

- Four consortia: CAPES/Brazil, CRKN/Canada, DOE/US, and Lyrasis/US (our largest, with 132 members)
- Active Members: The Americas region represents 28% of our membership base and 30% of our total member integrations. In 2019 our Americas members released new ORCID policies and integrations for grants, publishing, research resources, and institutions.
- Active Users: There was a 67% increase (2,423,062) in unique registry users in the Americas in 2019





2020 ORCID Board Elections

We are seeking Board Directors from every region and sector to take an active role in our governance and strategy as we transition into sustainability and persistence.

The elections process is overseen by the <u>Nominations</u> <u>Committee</u>, chaired by ORCID Board member <u>Ed Pentz</u>.

Being a Director

- Directors serve for a three-year term, with meetings three times per year and
 - Oversee organizational and financial performance
 - Develop and regularly update the strategic plan
 - Review high-level organizational goals
 - Serve on Board committees
 - Use their experience and skills to help ORCID achieve its mission
