

ORCID'S VISION IS A WORLD WHERE ALL WHO PARTICIPATE IN RESEARCH, SCHOLARSHIP, AND INNOVATION ARE UNIQUELY IDENTIFIED AND CONNECTED TO THEIR CONTRIBUTIONS AND AFFILIATIONS ACROSS TIME, DISCIPLINES, AND BORDERS.



Imagine a world where

- research information is openly available
- researchers are accurately credited for their contributions
- research institutions are accurately cited
- funders can track impact of funding and resources
- publishers can streamline submission and review processes
- accurate search and discovery tools are available
- researchers can easily share electronic information about their contributions and affiliations
- evaluators have access to open data to study knowledge flows



Building Research Infrastructure

- A well-implemented strategy requires suitable research infrastructures and support.
- Open information infrastructure is needed for creation of trusted linkages between researchers, research institutions, publishers, and funding organizations




The Value of Identifiers

The ORCID Community

- ORCID is a non-profit, membership, and platformneutral organization. ORCID is sustained by members from publishers, funders, research institutes and others
- ORCID is governed by representatives from a Board.
 Over 0 million researchers have registered for an iD.
- Over 9 million researchers have registered for an iD
- Over 1000 member organizations in 48 countries, including 24 national consortia
- 600+ research systems using ORCID in all sectors

Global Trends

Publishers

- Publishers and repositories around the world use DOIs and ISBNs to persistently identify journals, datasets, and books
- Nearly 6000 publisher and journal systems currently collect ORCID iDs during manuscript submission [video]. Many are also using ORCID for peer review.

Funders

 Over 20 funders have issued a policy or statement relating to the use of ORCID iD, several collect ORCID during grant application, and some are requiring ORCID, including <u>Wellcome</u> <u>Trust</u>, <u>US National Institutes of Health</u>, and the <u>Australian</u> <u>Research Council.</u>







Organizations need to


- Build an infrastructure to support the use of persistent identifiers like ORCID first

 - From HR system, research management system, publishing system, repository system, Profile system or customized ones all appropriate






Benefits for Organizations
