WHAT IS ORCID?



A globally unique and open identifier for researchers



Researchers share their iD with organizations during regular research workflows



A place to store and share the resulting connections between iDs and research activities and affiliations



The ORCID Community

- ORCID is a non-profit, membership, and platform-neutral organization. ORCID is sustained by members from publishers, funders, research institutes and others
- ORCID is governed by representatives from a Board.
- Over 9 million researchers have registered for an iD
- Over 1000 member organizations in 48 countries, including 24 national consortia
- 600+ research systems using ORCID in all sectors


APAC accounts for the second largest source of traffic to the ORCID Registry *data covers Jan - August 2020

INTEGRATING WITH ORCID API





ORCID PROVIDES

Plumbing for research informationTools to build trust in digital information



Persistent digital identifiers to distinguish researchers from each other



Member-built integrations that connect researchers and their activities/affiliations



A hub for synchronizing machine-readable connections between identifiers for people, organizations, and research activities



ORCID ENABLES





Organizations use the ORCID API to authenticate, collect, display, and connect persistent identifiers for people, places, and things in research workflows





ORCID REGISTRY CONNECTIONS

Two models:

- 1. Connect via a vendor system
 - Manuscript submission/publication
 - Document/data repositories
 - Profile systems
 - CRIS systems
- 2. Develop a custom connection







COLLECT & CONNECT WORKFLOW




For instance, in research management workflow, you collect information about your researchers' research outputs (e.g., publications) and fill into your system



Connect: Publishing

COLLECT & CONNECT WORKFLOW




ORCID members can use the Member API to connect publication metadata with **ORCID** records that will be available to other systems and organizations accessing the records, adding trust and transparency.



Connect: Research Institute

COLLECT & CONNECT WORKFLOW



ORCID members can use the Member API to make assertions about the connections between individuals and your organization with ORCID records



Why Connect?

 Authoritative: Validated data that will flow into any research ecosystem

• Trusted assertion: Improve search and

retrieval








ORCID Integration Workflow

- 1. Test in the sandbox environment.
 - To obtain Sandbox Public API credentials, register for a Sandbox ORCID iD, sign into your Sandbox ORCID record, go to the "Developer tools" tab, and complete the form.
 - To obtain Sandbox Member API credentials complete <u>the form</u>



ORCID Integration Workflow

2. Make your integrations live

- To obtain Production Public API credentials, sign in to your ORCID record, go to the "Developer tools" tab, and complete the form
- To obtain Production Member API credentials, ORCID membership is mandatory. And organizations need to provide a demo of the plugin working in the Sandbox environment to ensure they follow the best practices



Take Actions

- Publisher: signing the publishers open letter
- Funder: singing the funder open letter
- Integrating with ORCID
- Making the most of ORCID by following <u>Collect & Connect Best Practices</u>
