# WHAT IS ORCID?



A globally unique and open identifier for researchers



Researchers share their iD with organizations during regular research workflows



A place to store and share the resulting connections between iDs and research activities and affiliations





# The ORCID Community

- ORCID is a **non-profit, membership, and platform-neutral** organization. ORCID is sustained by members from publishers, funders, research institutes and others
- ORCID is governed by representatives from a Board.
- Over 9 million researchers have registered for an iD
- Over 1000 member organizations in 48 countries, including 24 national consortia
- 600+ research systems using ORCID in all sectors

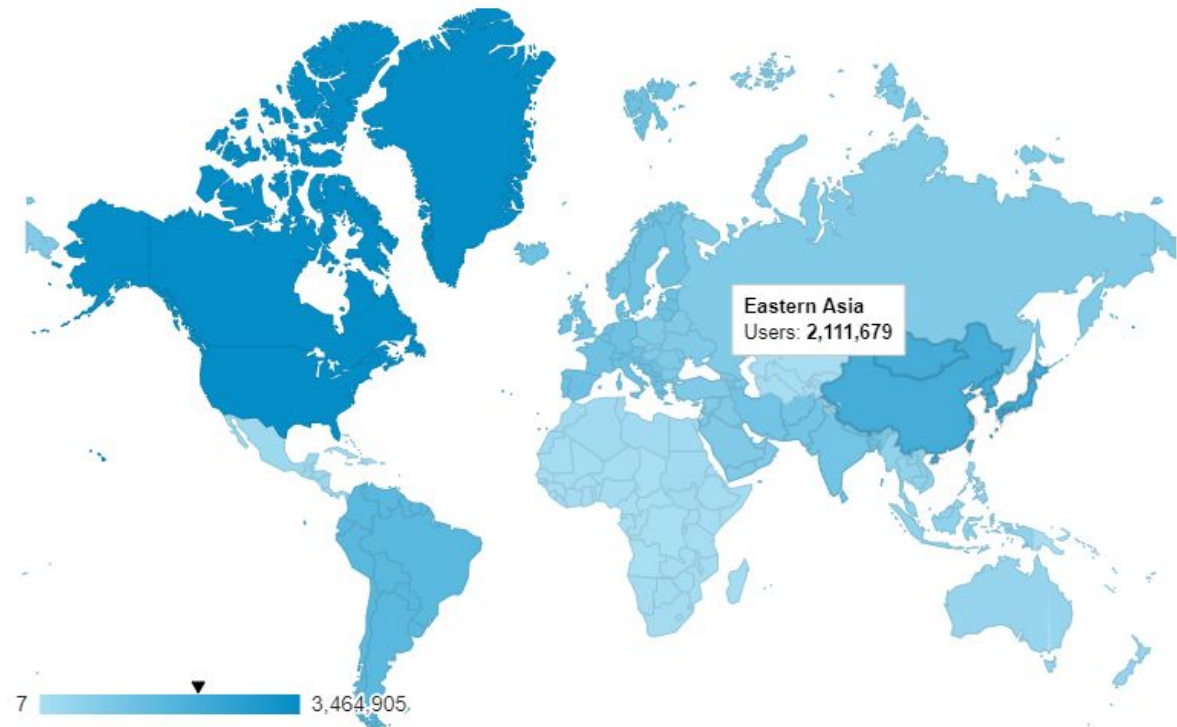

# ORCID Users the in APAC

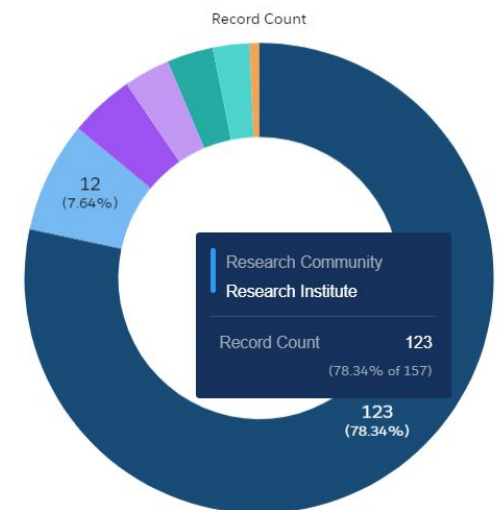
APAC accounts for the second largest source of traffic to the ORCID Registry \*data covers Jan - August 2020





# ORCID Members in the APAC

- 160+ members in total
- 130+ integrations - connections between ORCID members' systems with ORCID Registry
- 4 Consortia (Australia, Japan, New Zealand and Taiwan)
- Research institutes account for most members

# ORCID PROVIDES

- ✓ Plumbing for research information
- ✓ Tools to build trust in digital information



Persistent digital identifiers to distinguish researchers from each other



Member-built integrations that connect researchers and their activities/affiliations



A hub for synchronizing machine-readable connections between identifiers for people, organizations, and research activities



# ORCID ENABLES



Organizations use the ORCID API to authenticate, collect, display, and connect persistent identifiers for people, places, and things in research workflows





# ORCID REGISTRY CONNECTIONS

Two models:

1. Connect via a vendor system
  - Manuscript submission/publication
  - Document/data repositories
  - Profile systems
  - CRIS systems
2. Develop a custom connection

# GET PERMISSION



ORCID registry depends on user-based permissions:  
Can I...

- have your iD (*/authenticate*)   
- read limited-access data on your record (*/read-limited*) 
- interact with the activities on your record (*/activities/update*)  
- interact with your biographical information (*/person/update*)

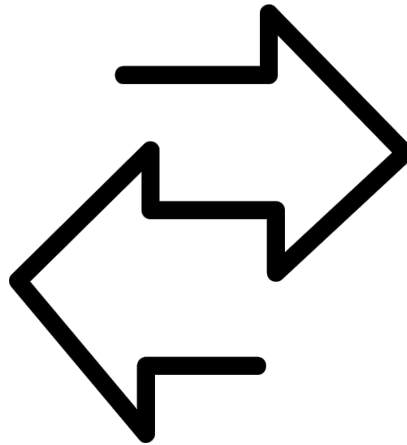

# Collect: Publishing

## COLLECT & CONNECT WORKFLOW

### — PUBLISHERS

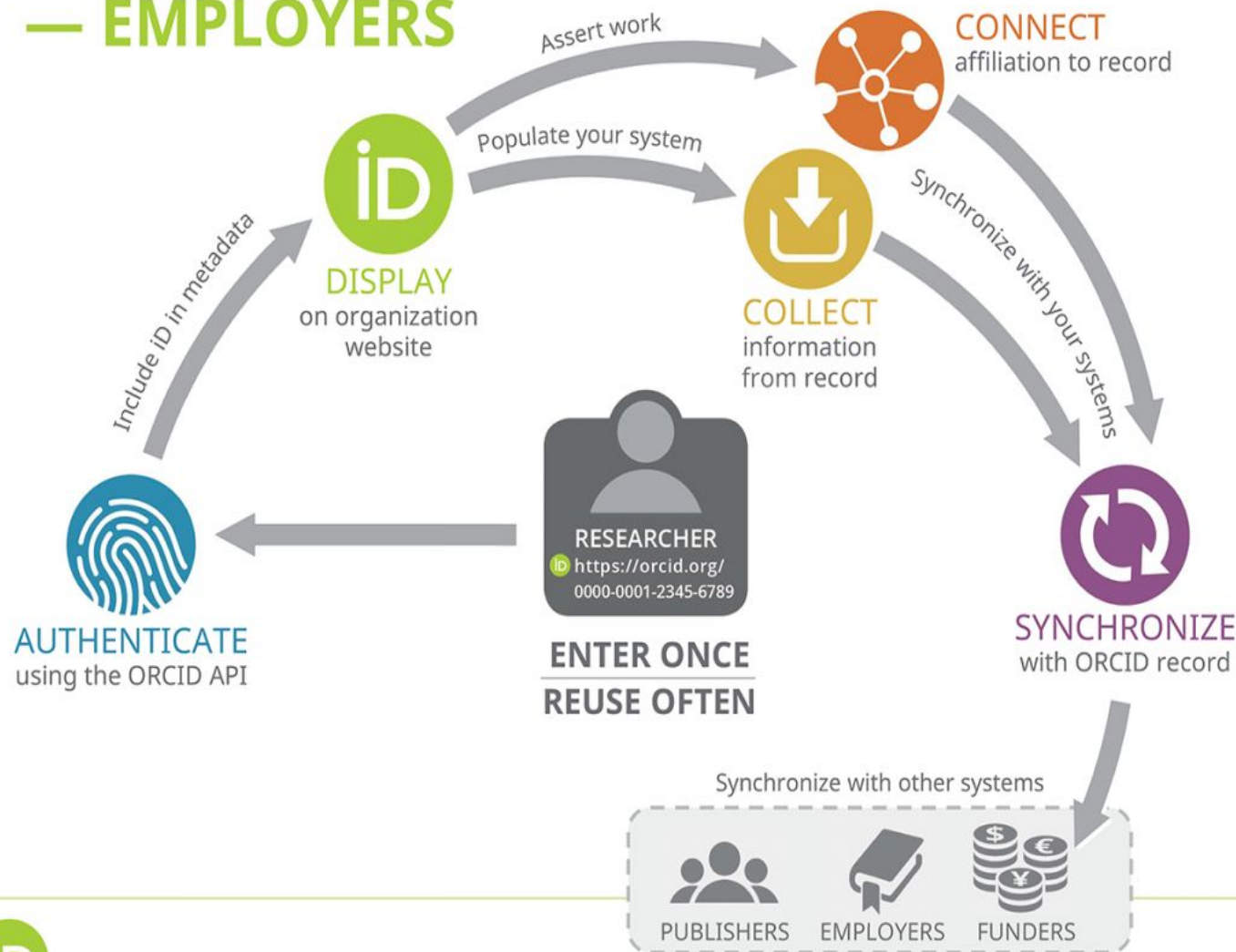


- **Collect** information from researcher' ORCID record to **pre-fill** in your system
- For instance, in publishing workflow, you collect your authors' basic information and pre-fill into your submission system

# Collect: Research Institute

## COLLECT & CONNECT WORKFLOW

### — EMPLOYERS



For instance, in research management workflow, you **collect** information about your researchers' research outputs (e.g., publications) and fill into your system



# Connect:Publishing

## COLLECT & CONNECT WORKFLOW

### — PUBLISHERS

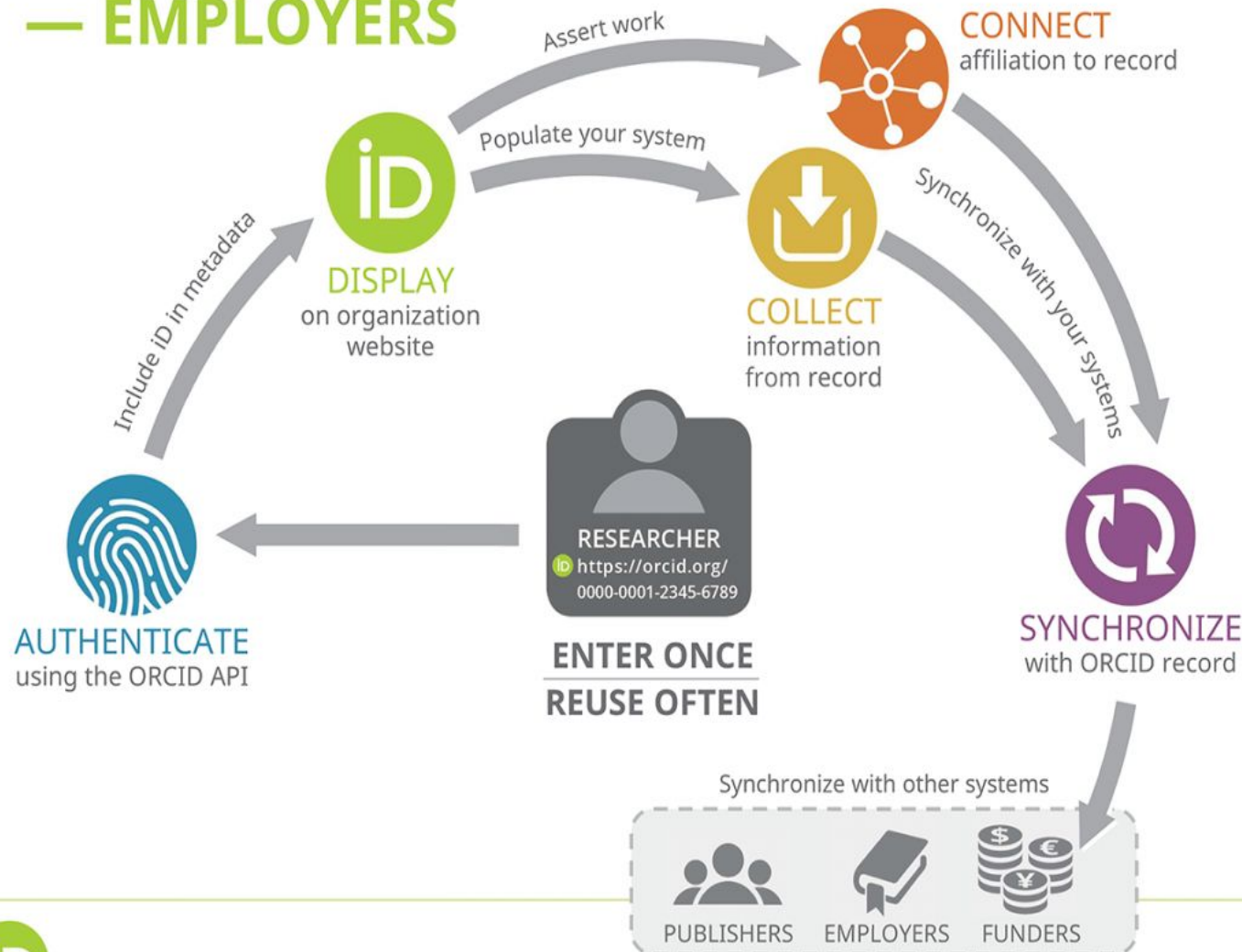


- ORCID members can use the Member API to **connect** publication metadata with ORCID records that will be available to other systems and organizations accessing the records, adding trust and transparency.

# Connect: Research Institute

## COLLECT & CONNECT WORKFLOW

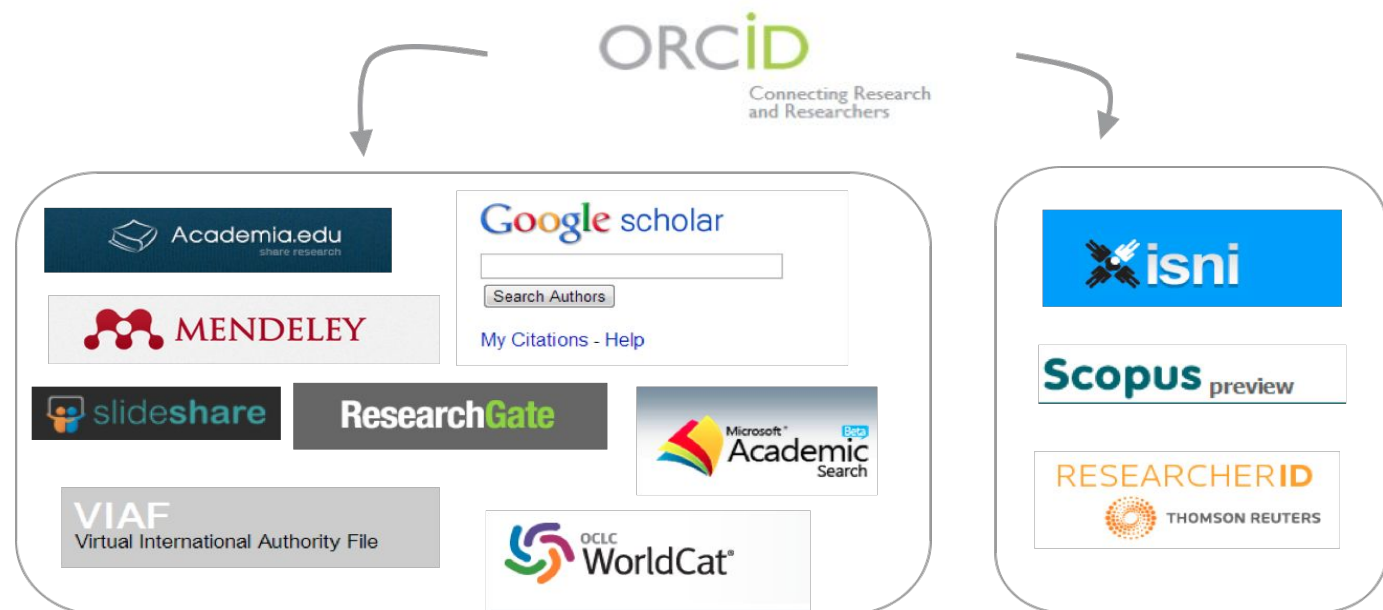
### — EMPLOYERS



ORCID members can use the Member API to **make assertions** about the **connections** between **individuals** and **your organization** with ORCID records

# Why Connect?

- Authoritative: Validated data that will flow into any research ecosystem
- Trusted assertion: Improve search and retrieval

# ORCID Integration Workflow

1. Test in the sandbox environment.
  - To obtain Sandbox Public API credentials, register for a Sandbox ORCID iD, sign into your Sandbox ORCID record, go to the “Developer tools” tab, and complete [the form](#).
  - To obtain Sandbox Member API credentials complete [the form](#)

# ORCID Integration Workflow

## 2. Make your integrations live

- To obtain Production Public API credentials, sign in to your ORCID record, go to the “Developer tools” tab, and complete [the form](#)
- To obtain Production Member API credentials, ORCID membership is mandatory. And organizations need to provide a demo of the plugin working in the Sandbox environment to ensure they follow the best practices
