DISCIPLINES, AND BORDERS.




What is ORCID?

- An open, non profit organization, created by and for the research community
- •A persistent unique identifier for individuals connected to a **record** (affiliations, works, funding metadata)
- A Registry / Hub to synchronize data
- •An international scale open research effort (and a community of practice!)



Why ORCID?

To **disambiguate** names and uniquely identify contributors.





Structure of the ORCID iD

https://orcid.org/0000-0002-1825-0097


- Persistent and unique identifier for people linked to research (researchers and contributors)
- 16 character alphanumeric code
- Complies with ISO 27729

ORCID privacy

By default, who should be able to see information added to your ORCID Record?

- Everyone (87% of users choose this)
- Trusted parties (5% of users choose this)
- Only me (8% of users choose this)

 Email addresses are private by default



- Privacy control of the registry for each entry individually
- In accordance with GDPR and privacy acts.



A little bit of history....





Challenges around peer review

- Lack of recognition, <u>specially for early career</u> researchers
- Biased & unprofessional reviews
- Increased need for peer review due to <u>COVID-19</u> and "preprints explosion"



How can ORCID help?

- Lack of recognition, specially for early career researchers
 - ORCID allows to recognize reviews in different (and in many ways!)
- Increased need for peer review due to COVID-19 and "preprints explosion"
 - Reward your reviewers by giving them credit via their ORCID records
- Biased & unprofessional reviews
 - Use ORCID to select reviewers (based on their previous contributions, expertise, etc.)




Peer review on ORCID

Peer review section

- Based on CASRAI Peer Review Services data profile
- Review items can only be added by a trusted (member) organization using API – users cannot self-assert

- o Role:* e.g. chair, editor, member, organizer, reviewer
- Group identifier:* The group ID used for aggregation purposes -- for journal articles, the default identifier is the eISSN, which is automatically populated via an integration with the ISSN database
- Convening organization*: a journal publisher, conference organizer, funding agency, faculty, etc
 - Organization identifier: Ringgold, GRID, LEI or Crossref Funder Registry identifier.
- Review data:* This data refers to the review activity and not what was reviewed
 - Type: The type of review activity, e.g. review, evaluation
 - Date: The date the review was completed. This can be broad (2008) or specific (2010-12-10)
 - Review identifier: A unique, resolvable identifier provided by the source of the review itself.





Peer review on ORCID

Service affiliation

- Available in user interface and in API 3.0 and higher users can also assert
- Opportunity to recognize service to an organization as reviewer, e.g. expert review panel, conference panel chair


• Organization:

- Organization name: The name of the organization at the highest level (e.g. "Boston University", rather than "Boston University School of Medicine").
- Address: The city, region, and country (or territory) where the organization is located. Only city and country are required, and the country should be populated with the two letter ISO 3166 Alpha-2 country code.
- Organization identifier: A unique identifier for the organization and its source. Currently ORCID supports Ringgold and GRID identifiers.
- Start date
- **Department name**: Any subdivision of the parent organization.
 - Role title/Degree: The position held, or the degree awarded or to be awarded.

- Review activity or review service to records
- Use unique reference ID


 Affiliations, works, review history, etc from records

SYNCHRONIZE

 Auto-update records and your databases




Connecting your ORCID iD (authentication)




- Ensuring that the iD is transmitted correctly
- Avoid errors when inserting the iD in the metadata (typographical errors, reconciliation errors, etc.)
- Be aware of what use permissions are granted





and Researchers



ScienceOpen offers a full suite of tools to peer review and curate preprints. Article reviews, after the model of book reviews, are published with the author's ORCID and a Crossref DOI for a high level of discoverability. Any user on ScienceOpen can invite another researcher to formally review any preprint. Currently, researchers need to have 5 publications linked to their ORCID to peer review.


