# ORCID for consortia

A CoP is a group that “share a concern or a passion for something they do and learn how to do it better as they interact regularly”

Wenger-Trayner

ORCID consortia – groups of five or more not-for-profit organizations – receive deep membership fee discounts, in return for taking responsibility for consortium administration, governance, and community engagement.



# Consortia roles & responsibilities

Each consortium appoints a lead organization, whose role is to catalyze the adoption of ORCID in their community:

- provide administrative support to their consortium
- manage the onboarding of consortium members
- support consortium members
- develop shared resources, communication materials and events
- work and support the consortium to identify goals, develop policy and governance, and establish regular progress reporting to members and ORCID

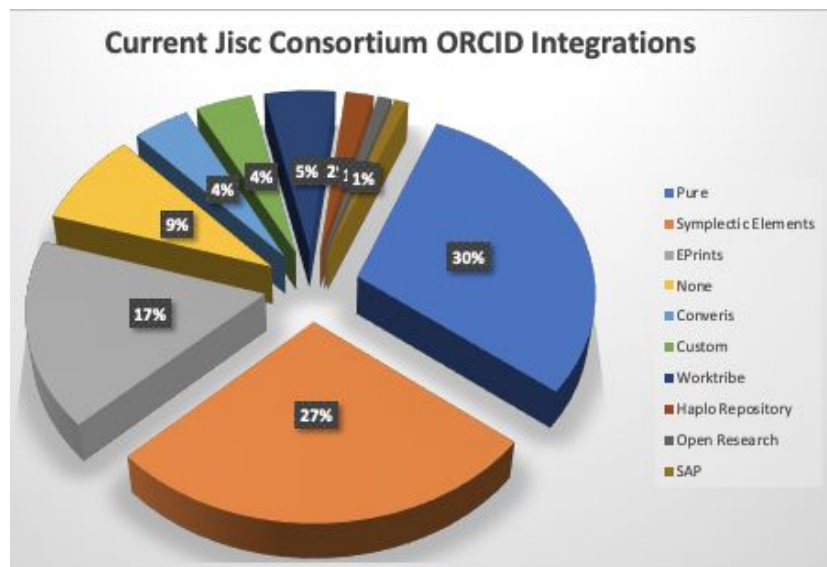

Evolving PID landscape



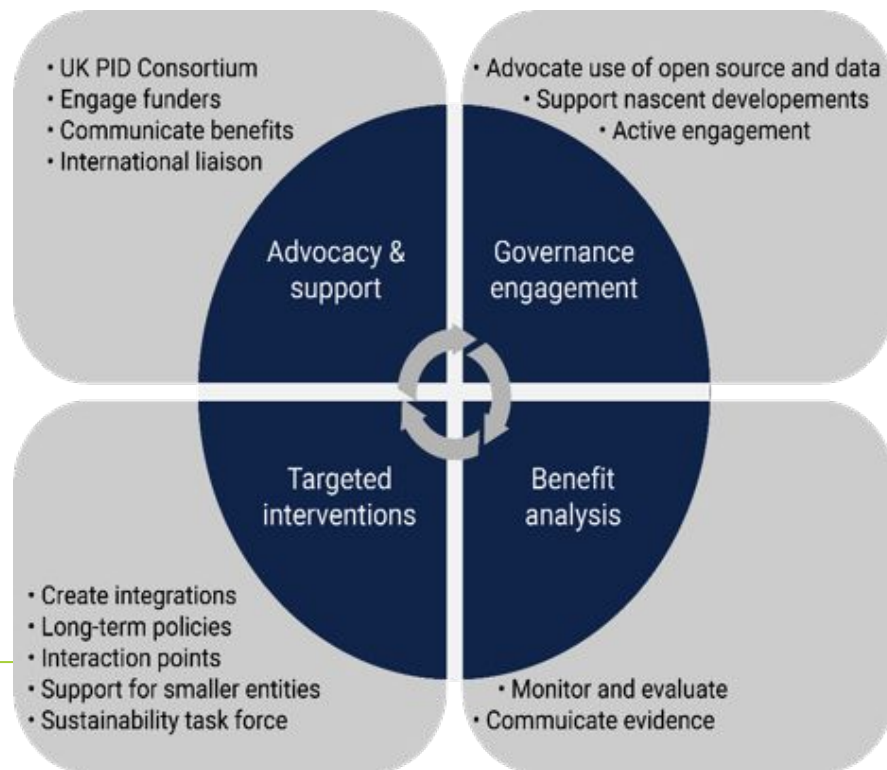

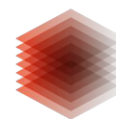

ORCID-Monitor: a tool (UI & API!) to analyze the use of ORCID data in BASE, repositories & other platforms

Allow claiming from titles within the DACH region & enable synchronization between ORCID & GND

Members integrating ORCID and their institutional ERP system, some integrations are actually built into the ERP (Oracle), and some use an intermediate mechanism ( web server & a database)

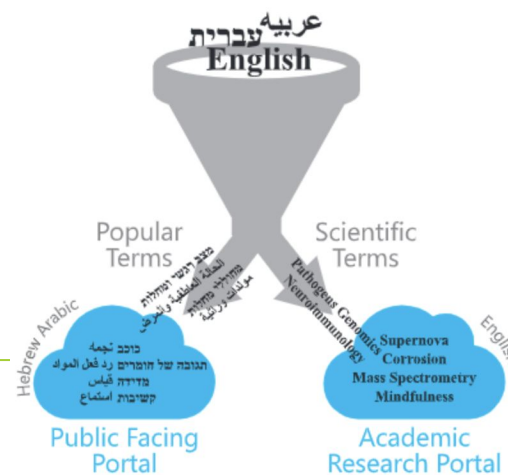
All integrations add affiliation data (org ID, start date, department) & keywords
