- Community-governed by a Board of Directors representative of our membership






### **ORCID** provides open infrastructure

- Persistent identifiers (PIDs) for researchers connected to a record of (affiliations, works, funding, and more) metadata
- A Registry / **Hub** to synchronize metadata
- APIs for connecting researchers with other identifiers for their contributions and activities
- A global community effort to build/share connections and tools

# Many countries and funders are adopting ORCID as part of their national research strategies

By way of this Notice, NIH, AHRQ, and CDC announce that individuals supported by research training, fellowship, research education, and career development awards **will be required to have ORCID iDs** (Open Researcher and Contributor Identifiers) beginning in FY 2020.




### **ORCID** in the Czech Republic

- Registry available in Czech since 2017
- 7 institutional members
- 6 integrations
- 16489 works with CZ country code



### **ORCID Consortia Program**

- Consortia program established in 2014 to to foster ORCID adoption via CoPs
- Group of 5+ non profit organizations
- National coordination and support provided by a lead organization
- 24 consortia with 945 members
- 739 Member API integrations
- 2 Consortia workshops
- Consortia Interest Group

### Recommendations to get started

#### Consortium

- Identify Lead org
- Determine how the consortium will be funded
- Identify support model and cost recovery model for consortium staff
- Draft policy for consortium, outlining goals of the consortium, membership criteria, governance principles, and how progress will be monitored
- Put out a call for participation in the consortium
- Determine whether implementation approach
- Develop a web page with information about the consortium lead, support contact, and basic information about ORCID best practices


- Answer consortium questions
- Support discussions about consortium
- Provide introductions to other CLs
- Provide basic training to CL staff
- Onboard members in Member Portal
- Promote launch

### **Consortia use cases: Italy**

- Established in 2015, led by Cineca
- Goal: to improve the handling and availability of data for the Italian national research evaluation exercise
- After a successful implementation pilot, Cineca build the Italian National ORCID HUB/IRIS (Dspace-CRIS)
- The tool allows researchers to connect their iDs and consortium members to import works and push affiliation and works data to ORCID records

### **Consortia use cases: France**

- Established in 2019, led by Couperin Abes
- Goal: to increase French participation in the European and international open science landscape (1st National Plan for Open Science)
- HAL (open repo) Integration: enables researchers to connect their iDs and populate their ORCID records with works metadata

### Consortia use cases: UK

- Established in 2015, led by Jisc
- After the Jisc ARMA ORCID Pilot to streamline ORCID implementation at (8) HEIs the consortium was launched to federate benefits of ORCID adoption
- UKRI OA Policy requires iDs for contributors to be supported in repository and publishing systems
- UK ORCID consortium cost benefit analysis: total saving (>8Y) is estimated to be £4M
