Akadémiai Kiadó:

AKJournal

- founded in 1828, leading STM publisher in Hungary and in Eastern Europe

AKJournals: publishing

AKCongress AKCongress: scientific congress organizations

AK Journals: publishing journals, scientific books, language books, business books, popular books, dictonaries







Akadémiai Kiadó:

AK Journals: - 58 current journals, oldest one was founded in 1857

- 10 of our journals are co-published with Springer Nature
- 11 GOLD Open Access journals
- 48 out 58 are in english

Our yearly production turnover: 3672 articles / year (we have 2 000 0000+ full text downloads/year)







ORCID usage at our Journals:

- ORCID can entered during submitting manuscripts by authors using online submission systems
- 33 out of 58 journals have online submission & peer-review systems (17 EM+16 OJS 2.x)
- EM: authors can enter ORCID + use ORCID for login/authentification
- OJS 2.x: author can add ORCID to the OJS profile

Current situation: we are just collecting ORCID, but don't use it...







What next? – let's explore and use it!

1. Motivate authors to enter it! – Offering faster publishing process? Discount from OA fees?

2. Supporting review process and editorial boards – tracking authors, ckecking potential candidates for reviewing, presenting reviewing activity on ORCID profile & tracking reviewing activities, etc.

3. Supporting and speed up publishing workflow: importing metadata from ORCID (affiliations, etc.)

4. Supporting the usage: present it in the published papers: in pdf, in XML, etc.





What next? – We need support from stakeholders!
